Your smartphone or tablet is connected to a 2.4GHz Wi-Fi network. (The robot only support 2.4GHz network.)2. Your smartphone or tablet is running iOS 8.0 (or above) or Android 4.4 (or above).3. The Wi-Fi status light on robot is rapidly flashing blue.4. Open the Google Home app.2. Say “OK Google, talk to Robot” to the Google Assistant-enabled device (i.e. Google Home) to initiate the Google action for Robot.3. Follow the instructions in the Google Home app to authorize Google Assistant with your Robot account.4.
